A founding member of the International Thomas Merton Society, she served as its third president, and received a 'Louie' award for service to the Society. She has published extensively and given retreats and lectures on Merton in the U.S., Canada, the U.K., and Europe. She edited Merton And Buddhism, Hidden in the Same Mystery: Thomas Merton & Loretto (both with Fons Vitae) and Thomas Merton on Eastern Meditation (New Directions).
